## VESTRY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

### Meeting of September 19th

1. The treasurer's report reflected the continued faithfulness of our congregation in their giving.
2. Committee reports:
  - Christian Education—a newly prepared brochure describes our Sunday School "Rotation" program.
  - Parish Life—Fish Fry at White's on October 20th. Also, members of our congregation will be providing the meals each Wednesday evening during October. Volunteers are needed.
  - Stewardship Program—plans for October reviewed.
  - Outreach—we will 'tithe' 10% of the grant we received from the Plummer Foundation for two new and additional outreach projects. One project will begin in October. This will be some financial training for families that frequently ask for aid from community agencies.
3. Reviewed plans for Diocesan Council in November and our participation. Delegates are Brian Charbonneau, Allen Dutch and Louis Tonsmeire.

## INCREASING OUR OUTREACH EFFORTS

For a long time, our 'norm' for Outreach in the community has been 10% of our yearly income. When we 'trimmed the budget', once the pledges were received, much of that decrease was in the Outreach line item. In 2007, our Outreach line item has been about 5% or \$6000.00.

Special gifts and offerings, beyond that line item, were in excess of \$2000. However, our goal is to increase our Outreach budget and will be an emphasis in our educational process in October.

# Hands That Give

There are many ways you can give to others.  
All you have to do is lend a hand!

### What you need:

- Colored paper
- Scissors
- Markers or crayons
- Yarn or heavy string
- Clothespins or paper clips

### What you do:

1. With your parents' help, think of seven (or more) things that you can do for seven (or more) people. For example, you could clean out closets and donate the items to charity, help a neighbor bring in her trash, and so on.
2. Trace your hand on the paper seven times. Cut out each hand.
3. On one side of each hand, write a person's name. On the other side, write how you will help him or her.
4. Cut a long piece of yarn (or heavy string) and hang it in your room – like a clothesline.
5. Use the clothespins or paper clips to hang each hand on the "clothesline."
6. When you've completed each act of service, take the hand off, but keep it to use another time.
7. Do this activity over and over again by "giving a hand" to someone.
